

One Province, One Card



Wheatland Regional Library is part of a provincial consortium called Saskatchewan Information & Library Services Consortium (SILS). A provincial grant of \$5.2 million, spread over 4 years, has enabled all of the public libraries in Saskatchewan to connect on one library system. As part of the initiative, all public libraries in the province have agreed on a new set of borrowing rules and late charges. Over 300 libraries across the province are involved in this agreement, unprecedented in Canada, and a testament to our Prairie spirit!

All 11 public library agencies in this province will gradually migrate to the new single integrated library system over the next year. Wheatland Regional Library is part of the later phase and is expected to migrate sometime in mid to late 2010.

Some of the exciting changes include:

- >> A new state-of-the-art computer system which will eventually include a number of features for the library catalogue, including a separate catalogue for children;
- >> A customized library card account and improved security measures;
- >> Improved access to our website and online resources;
- >> A centralized notification system for holds and overdues, including e-mail; and more!
