

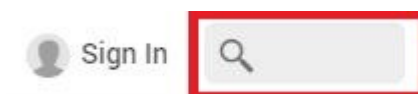
Getting Started with PressReader

PressReader is an online platform that allows you to read nearly 6000 newspapers and magazines from around the world. Follow these steps to get started reading and get the best experience possible.

Using PressReader On a Computer:

Go to the Wheatland website at www.wheatland.sk.ca and find Press Reader Newspapers under “Online Library”. Login with your Library card number and your 4 digit PIN to get free access.

If you’d like to create a PressReader account click on Sign In located at the top right of the screen and then follow steps 3 and 4 below.



Using PressReader on a Tablet or Smartphone:

You can use PressReader on your smart phone or tablet:

- 1) Search for “PressReader” in the app store. Download the free app.
- 2) Before you can read the newspapers, you will need to login. Go to the Sign In button on the bottom right. Choose “Libraries and other Groups”.
- 3) Search for “Saskatchewan” (do not search for Wheatland). Click on the Library—Saskatchewan Public Libraries (Ministry of Education) (Offsite) option.
- 4) Enter your library barcode number with no spaces and your PIN. If you need help resetting your PIN



please contact your local librarian.

Tips and Tricks!

- Use the search button to find specific newspapers you want to read (for example: StarPhoenix). If you just want to browse, you can You can also read older editions of magazines and newspapers by scrolling down (on the app) or to the right (on a computer).
- When you are signed into your account you can add publications to your favourites list by clicking the heart beside the title.
